Day 1, Wednesday, March 10, 2010: BEGIN OUR JOURNEY

Depart the United States on our overnight flight to Israel.

Day 2 – Thursday, March 11, 2010: WELCOME TO ISRAEL!

Arrival in Israel this morning...Ayelet Tours staff assistance... Meet our guide and begin our tour... We begin with a tree planting opportunity in a JNF Forest... Continue north and arrive at our kibbutz... Dinner and overnight at our Kibbutz in the Galilee. (D)

Day 3 - Friday, March 12, 2010: EXPLORING THE NORTH

Breakfast... We spend our day exploring the landscape of the northern region, beginning at the mystical city of Safed... Tour the Artists Quarter and ancient synagogues of this kabbalistic center... In the early afternoon we take a tour of the Golan, stopping atop Har Bental to take in the breathtaking panorama stretching into neighboring Syria... Return to our kibbutz with time to freshen up before Shabbat dinner together... Overnight Kibbutz in the Galilee. (B,D)

Day 4 – Shabbat, March 13, 2010: THE MAGIC OF SHABBAT IN THE NORTH

Breakfast... This morning we will enjoy a Shabbat hike through our local surroundings... This afternoon we travel through Kiryat Shmone to Kibbutz Misgav Am, where we meet with Kibbutz members to discuss life on the Border with Lebanon. After Shabbat ends, we travel through the Jordan Valley toward Jerusalem... We stop at the Haas Promenade overlooking the Old City walls for a chance to recite the "Sh'hekiyanu!" blessing... Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

Day 5 – Sunday, March 14, 2010: UNDER THE GROUND TO ABOVE THE CITY WALLS

After breakfast, we begin our tour of Jerusalem's Old City... Walking tour of the Jewish Quarter including the Cardo market, the Christian Quarter, and the bazaar... We stop at the Western Wall and enjoy a tour of the Western Wall tunnels, an awe-inspiring journey through time, and keyhole to Jerusalem's ancient past... Evening ramparts walk, giving us a birds-eye view of the living quarters and historic landmarks within the walled city... Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

Day 6 – Monday, March 15, 2010: JERUSALEM'S NEW CITY

Breakfast... Yad Vashem, Israel's memorial dedicated to the victims of the Holocaust... Continue to Mt. Herzl to visit the cemetery where Theodore Herzl, Golda Meir, and Yitzhak Rabin are buried... Tour the Mt. Herzl Museum where we learn about one of Israel's great historical leaders... Return to the Old City area for a tour of the Ir David excavations, including a walk through the Hezekiah Water Tunnels (wear water-friendly shoes)... Overnight Jerusalem. (B)

Day 7 – Tuesday, March 16, 2010:

We begin the day visiting the trenches and memorial to the soldiers of the Six-Day War at Ammunition Hill... Visit the One Center Jerusalem, dedicated to working with terror trauma victims, and families of terror victims... Overnight Jerusalem (B)

Day 8 – Wednesday, March 17, 2010: MASADA AND THE DEAD SEA BASIN

We depart the Jerusalem area this morning and head toward the Dead Sea Basin... We begin at the desert oasis of Ein Gedi, where King David hid from Saul among the beautiful waterfalls... Ascend Masada and tour King Herod's fortress, where Jewish zealots chose to perish rather than surrender to the Romans... Have a chance to experience an "unsinkable swim" in the salty waters of the Dead Sea... Spend the evening with a Bedouin community in the desert, including dinner hospitality & a camel ride under the stars... Overnight Mitzpe Ramon (B,D)

Day 9 – Thursday, March 18, 2010: DEEP INTO THE LAND

Breakfast... This morning we enjoy an amazing sunrise Jeep tour in the Ramon Crater... after sunrise, we return to the hotel for breakfast... Visit with Bedouin Herbalist Miriam Abu Regayak... This afternoon, we travel to Sde Boker to visit the gravesite and desert hut of David Ben Gurion... Dinner and overnight Mitzpe Ramon. (B,D)

Day 10 – Friday, March 19, 2010:

Breakfast and hotel check out... We enjoy a "hands-on" archeological dig at Beit Guvrin, including an exciting cave crawl... We continue to Tel Aviv for time at leisure, including a visit to the artisans of Nachlat Binyamin and the wares of the Carmel Market... Travel back to Jerusalem for hotel check in and time to Freshen up for Shabbat. This evening we welcome Shabbat at the Western Wall and enjoy Shabbat dinner together at our hotel... Overnight Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 11 – Saturday, March 20, 2010: SHABBAT IN JERUSALEM

Breakfast... Shabbat Shalom!.. Day at leisure to enjoy the calm of Shabbat. On own options include a visit to the Israel Museum and Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are preserved and displayed, or the museum of Islamic Art... This evening we enjoy a Farewell Dinner and reflect on all we have done and seen together. Overnight Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 12 – Sunday, March 21, 2010: ARRIVE HOME

Morning transfer to Ben Gurion airport to meet our flight back to the United States, landing later today.
